




When we use **a reflexive pronoun** in this way, it means the same as *alone* or *independently* and is added for emphasis. In other words, it's grammatically correct to say *I made the cake*, but adding *myself* 😊 it was done without help.

Use the reflexive pronoun when the subject and the object are the same person.
